The Essex County Reintegration Program is operated by the One-Stop Career Center and is designed to assist in the reintegration of ex-offenders into the community. The program offers a wide range of services including intake and assessment, basic skills training, adult education, job training opportunities, and job placement assistance. Expungement services are available to those who qualify. The program relies on the network of support services offered at the One-Stop Career Center to better assist our customers.



Supportive Agencies

ESSEX COUNTY— DEPARTMENT OF CITIZEN SERVICES, DIVISION OF WELFARE

As part of the One-Stop system, Welfare services are offered to One-Stop customers.

The services provided are as follows:

Food Stamps, General Assistance (WFNJ/GA), Home Energy Assistance, Medicaid, Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF), and Transitional Services.

ESSEX COUNTY—DIVISION OF COMMUNITY ACTION

This Division serves as the County's anti-poverty agency and provides a number of valuable emergency assistance and social services to individuals facing crisis situations.


