The **Workforce Learning Link (WLL)** is a initiative in partnership with the NJ Department of Labor & Workforce Development (LWD) to help job seekers with instruction in reading, writing and math, communication, financial literacy, job search, employability and life-skills.



Using the computer, the Workforce Learning Link provides interactive training services that allow participants to learn at their own pace. The programs provide a wide range of self-paced learning opportunities in ESL, basic skills, pre-GED, and GED literacy, life and workplace skills.

To participate you must register with our One-Stop Career Center (OSCC) to take part in reemployment programs and mandatory programs. You also need to attend an orientation with the One-Stop office. **Registered participants must attend a mandatory 15 hours per week.** The workshops are Monday through Friday, with the exception of Holidays.

The **Workforce Learning Link (WLL)** is open to anyone who needs to improve their skills. It doesn't matter if you have a job or collecting unemployment. The instructor will get you started and help you with the computer if you need it.



Best of all, the literacy workshops are **FREE!**


