2019 ESSEX COUNTY LEGACIES WRITING CONTEST RULES

- ❖ Writers must be Essex County residents who are 60 years of age or older.
- ❖ Submit an *original* story focusing on a special person, a life altering experience or a significant period in your life.
 - *Bring to life for the reader the person or experience that deeply influenced your life – the visual images, other sensory memories, and the emotions and thoughts that make up your recollections;*
 - *Reflect on the times and the location of your story in the richness of your descriptions;*
 - *Give the reader a picture of your immediate environment with detail reflecting particular social, cultural and interpersonal influences in your home, family, neighborhood or other immediate surroundings at the time of your story;*
 - *If appropriate to the story, reflect the influence of broader historical events and/or your connections with the younger or older generation.*
- ❖ Suggested maximum length: 1,500 words. Stories must be typed or legibly written on 8½-by-11-inch paper. Sending stories by e-mail reduces errors after retyping. (E-mail stories to gbenoit@seniors.essexcountynj.org.)
- ❖ Entries must have a **cover page** with the story title and the following information: Author's name, date of birth, address and telephone number.
- ❖ A **heading with the story title only** (with no other identifying information) should appear on the first page of the story text. (Note: The cover page and all identifying information about the author is removed before the story is copied for the review committee.)
- ❖ *Authors may submit only one entry.*
- ❖ Authors should keep a copy of their entry. Stories are not returned. They are never used for any purpose without permission from the author.
- ❖ Previously published stories may not be submitted.
- ❖ The submission date for entries to the 2019 Essex County Legacies Contest is:
