REPROGRAMMING OF EMERGENCY SOLUTIONS GRANT (ESG) FUNDS  
AMENDMENTS TO THE 2010-2014 CONSOLIDATED PLAN – 2011, 2012 & 2013 ONE-YEAR  
ACTION PLANS

In accordance with U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development regulations governing the Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) Program, the County of Essex hereby notifies the public of its intent to amend its action plans. Non-Profit Agencies of Essex County are invited to submit applications for reprogrammed Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) Program funds, which are available through the Essex County Division of Housing and Community Development. The Division will reprogram \$102,715 from Program Year 2011, \$71,393 from Program Year 2012 and \$62,215 from Program Year 2013 in ESG funds recaptured from various projects. Projects to be funded will be Homeless Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing activities only.

Essex County proposes to work with the local homeless services system within Essex County, including the local Continuum of Care through its CEAS committee to identify not for profits to support homeless prevention and rapid re-housing activities. These not for profits shall have the requisite Homeless Management Information System in place and not require assistance in establishing such a system for reporting. All applications are due at the Division office prior to the close of business, Tuesday, November 12, 2013. Upon review and approval, the County will prepare amendments to its Action Plans for submission to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.
