

What are the Specified Low Income Medicare Beneficiary Program (SLMB) and the Specified Low-Income Medicare Beneficiary Qualify Individual Program (SLMBQ1-1)

The Specified Low Income Medicare Beneficiary Program (SLMB) and SLMB Q1-1 programs pay Medicare Part B premiums for individuals who are not eligible for New Jersey Care and Special Medicaid Programs, because their incomes are too high.

How to qualify for SLMB & SLMB Q1-1?

In order to qualify for SLMB & SLMB Q1-1 program, your annual countable income must be below \$12,996 single person or \$17,484 for a couple, and you must be enrolled in Medicare Part A (hospital) and Medicare Part B (medical).

Medicare Part B Premiums

The program pays your Medicare Part B premiums. At this time the current amount is \$96.40 per month. This amount is adjusted on a yearly basis.

What is the resource limit?

For all programs, the resource limit must not be more than \$4,000 if you are single or not more than \$6,000 if you are married.
