ESSEX COUNTY— DEPARTMENT OF CITIZEN SERVICES, DIVISION OF FAMILY ASSISTANCE AND BENEFITS

As part of the One-Stop system, Family Assistance and Benefits are offered to One-Stop customers. **The services provided are as follows:** Food Stamps, General Assistance (WFNJ/GA), Home Energy Assistance, Medicaid, Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF), and Transitional Services.

ESSEX COUNTY—DIVISION OF COMMUNITY ACTION

This Division serves as the County's anti-poverty agency and provides a number of valuable emergency assistance and social services to individuals facing crisis situations. **Individuals maybe referred to this agency for:** Emergency and Home Assistance; Homelessness Prevention; Basic Social Services; Tenant Counseling; Advocacy to Essex County Residents

NJ DEPARTMENT OF LABOR—EMPLOYMENT SERVICES

The New Jersey Department of Labor (DOL), interviews, assesses, tests, and evaluates One-Stop customers for job readiness or training before they are referred to an appropriate Workforce activity.

ESSEX—NEWARK LEGAL SERVICES

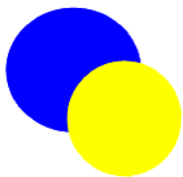

ESSEX COUNTY RE-ENTRY LEGAL SERVICES-(RELeSe)

ReLeSe is a legal services program of Volunteer Lawyers for Justice designed to help individuals with criminal records, and address civil legal matters that are barriers to a successful re-entry into the community. Eligibility is determined by ReLeSe. **Referrals provided by the Essex County Reintegration Unit.**
