DRESS CODE/RULES FOR VISITATION:

- No underwire bras may be worn. Only sport bras are allowed in order to clear the metal detector. (No exceptions.)
- All visitors including children must clear the metal detector in order to be granted an official visit (No clearance, no visit.)
- All belts and any accessories that will trigger the metal detector including shoes and boots must be removed and will be searched.
- All persons accessing the ECCF may be subjected to searches including, but not limited to:
 - o Metal Detector walk through
 - o Wand Scan
 - o Search of persons
 - o Pat Search
- Visitors may not wear clothing that resembles attire worn by inmates/detainees.

- Visitors may not wear adornments that could be used as weapons.
- Visitors may not wear clothing that displays gang signs, obscenities, drug or alcohol designs.
- No bare feet, hats, or scarves (**with the exception of religious scarves**) will be permitted.
- Visitors may not wear garments or halter tops which unduly exposes the shoulders, chest, back, stomach, midriff or underarms.
- Visitors may not wear clothing made of sheer, transparent material, net, mesh or any see through material.
- Dresses, skirts, jumpers, culottes, and shorts may not be worn. (**These cannot exceed four inches above the kneecap when standing.**)
- Visitors shall not exchange any article or property with an inmate/detainee
- No hoodies with zippers or jackets with buttons may be worn.
- Any clothing with pockets will be turned inside out for visual inspection.
- If you bring a child to visit, you must have the child's birth certificate with you. If you're not the legal guardian of that child, you must have a notarized letter from the parent allowing you to bring the child to the facility for a visit.

ALL OF THE ABOVE RULES WILL BE ENFORCED BY ALL OFFICERS ASSIGNED TO THE AREA.

ANY VISITORS NOT WILLING TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES MAY HAVE THEIR VISIT TERMINATED.

VISITORS WHO APPEAR TO BE UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF ALCOHOL, DRUGS OR DISPLAY UNRULY BEHAVIOR OR USE OBSCENITIES OR PROFANITY WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO ENTER THE FACILITY.

ALL VISITORS MUST CLEAR THE TEMPERATURE CHECK STATION AND PROPERLY WEAR A FACE MASK AT ALL TIMES AS WE FOLLOW THE CDC GUIDELINES FOR OUR SAFETY AS WELL AS YOURS.
