Requests must be submitted at least 72 hours prior to the meeting to make the appropriate arrangements.

The proposed substantial amendment to the PY 2022 One Year Action Plan is as follows:

For PY 2022, the Township of South Orange was awarded \$100,000 for ADA improvements to the front entrance of the Monella Center at 133 Fairview Avenue, South Orange. In conjunction with this activity, the Township planned for the installation of an ADA accessible elevator that would be funded by a \$128,000 grant from the NJ Department of Community Affairs and \$72,000 in capital funds from the Township based on preliminary estimates in May 2022. However, the current estimate for the elevator installation is expected to be up to \$100,000 higher than the original projected cost of \$200,000. To address this increase, the Township requests that the project scope as defined in the current contract be changed to installing the elevator and the PY 2022 CDBG award amount of \$100,000 be reallocated for the elevator installation, which is expected to be completed during the fall of 2023.

The Township notes that postponing the proposed improvements to the front entrance will not negatively impact ADA accessibility to the facility because the Township recently completed ADA improvements to the parking lot and rear entrance, which is utilized by most residents when visiting the site.
