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PROJECT BACKGROUND

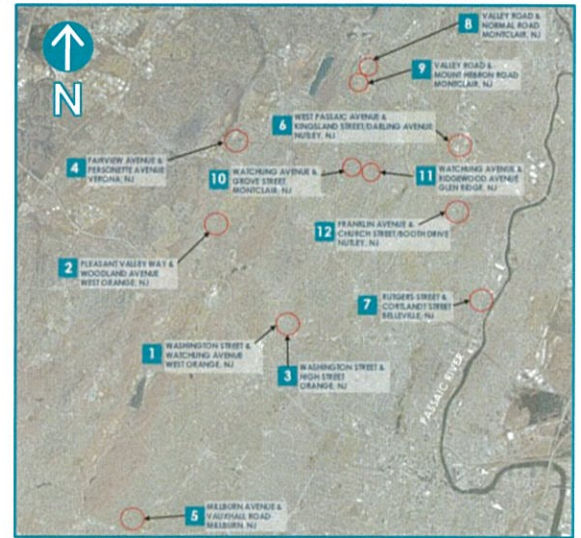
County Routes are owned and maintained by the County of Essex. County Routes are major transportation links in Essex County. The project limits encompass 12 various County Route intersection locations within the County. The County of Essex has proposed to undertake improvements, utilizing Federal Local Safety Program funding, to provide a safe roadway that accommodates current and future traffic demands. Improvements will meet current design standards and serves the local community while at the same time minimizing impacts to the environment.

COMMUNITY RELATIONS

Essex County, in conjunction with NJDOT and NJTPA, is committed to developing roadway improvements that satisfy local and regional transportation needs and safety concerns. Residents from the surrounding area are encouraged to actively participate by attending public information centers.
