COUNTYWIDE PUBLIC HEARING ON A
SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT TO THE PY 2025 ONE-YEAR ACTION PLAN

In accordance with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development regulations governing the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program, the County of Essex hereby notifies the public of its intent to amend its **PY 2025** One-Year Action Plan. Citizens of Essex County are invited to attend a public hearing on July 23, 2026, at 5:00 PM. This hearing will offer citizens the opportunity to assist in the review of the amendment proposed by the Essex County Division of Housing & Community Development prior to submission of the amendment to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development on or after August 11, 2026. The proposed substantial amendments to the PY 2025 One-Year Action Plan are as follows:

Township of Millburn was previously awarded PY 2025 CDBG funds of \$50,000 for ADA accessibility improvements to the Millburn Town Hall. At this time, the Township is requesting a change of scope for this award such that these funds would be reallocated for carrying out ADA accessibility improvements to the Short Hills/Millburn Train Station, which is located at 25 Chatham Road, Short Hills, NJ, 07078.
